CHICKEN APRICOT BAKE

Plump, glazed boneless chicken breasts are baked atop sweet 'n savory apricot-pecan stuffing that starts with a mix!

Shopping List

- 2 cups seasoned stuffing mix
- 2/3 cup dried apricots, chopped
- 1/3 cup coarsely chopped pecans
- 1/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 1 tsp. dried thyme
- 1/2 tsp. freshly ground pepper
- 2/3 cup hot water
- 4 boneless, skinless chicken breast halves, about 2 lbs.
- 2 Tbsp. apricot preserves

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Coat a 11 x 7-inch glass baking dish with cooking spray.

In large bowl, combine stuffing, apricots, pecans, brown sugar, thyme and pepper.

Stir in hot water until evenly moistened.

Spoon stuffing mixture evenly into baking dish.

Place chicken breasts on top of stuffing.

Spread chicken with preserves. Bake until chicken is no longer pink inside, 30-45 minutes.

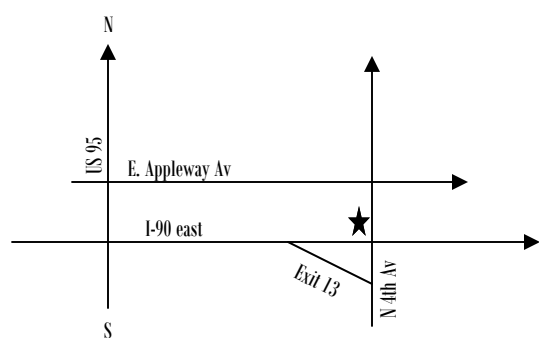

Flat Tappet and Camshaft Lobe Lubrication (submitted by club member Richard Neet)

Here are some facts outlining lubrication requirements of flat tappet and camshaft style engines and the effect of motor oil additives containing higher levels of zinc/phosphorus. Engine oils contain anti-wear additives and most common anti-wear chemistry is zinc dialkyldihiphosphate (ZnDDP), which contains a combination of zinc and phosphorus. In 2005, in an effort to guarantee catalytic converter performance in new vehicles, the American Petroleum Institute (API) instituted API SM quality standards which reduced the maximum limit of phosphorus to 0.080%. API SM specifications also contain a minimum phosphorus content of .060%.

API SL oils were restricted to 0.10% phosphorus levels, so a concern arose that oils containing lower levels of zinc/phosphorus could provide insufficient protection in high pressure areas of flat tappet and camshaft lobes found in many older cars and high-performance engines. High-performance modified engines benefit from oils with superior film strength and anti-wear properties. The flat tappet/camshaft lobe interface is the one area in an engine that has extreme contact load. The load increases significantly where non-stock, high-pressure valve springs are employed so the use of properly formulated engine lubricants is extremely important to reduce wear and extend flat tappet/camshaft life. In these applications, motor oils containing high levels of zinc/phosphorus are recommended for superior protection.

Proper assembly lubes and oil additives should be used during the break-in phase for all new or rebuilt engines with flat tappets. These additives provide the extra protection required at the point of contact during break-in to help the flat tappet face to properly mate with the cam lobe. One of the common products is GM E.O.S., which is an assembly lubricant and is not, as stated by GM, an engine oil additive. One oil additive that claims to reduce cam and lifter wear in high-performance and flat tappet compared to API SM rated oils is ZDDPlus.

Synthetic motor oils although meeting the API SM specifications still have oils that are API SL rated. The two top synthetics Amsoil and Mobile 1, make oils with levels of zinc/phosphorus that will give older cars and high-performance engines protection. With a little internet research the important numbers for zinc/phosphorus were found:

Amsoil 10W-40 synthetic	phosphorus level (ppm)1265	zinc level (ppm) 1378
Mobile 1 15W-50 synthetic	phosphorus level (ppm)1200	zinc level (ppm) .12% to .13%

I hope this information will help owners of older vehicles and hot rods keep them on the road longer and happier. Happy Motoring!

Recently, Skip Littell loaned one of his Tech Books to another member and it was quite useful to that member in solving a distinct problem he was having with his classic.
