### Zucchini Coconut Layer Cake

Zucchini Bread, Zucchini Cookies, Zucchini Cake,  
Zucchini this, Zucchini that...

Here's another great zucchini recipe to try!

- 1 pkg. (18.25 oz) French vanilla cake mix
- 3 eggs
- 1/3 cup oil
- 2 medium zucchini, grated (2 cups)
- 1 1/2 cups unsalted butter, at room temperature
- 1 16 oz. container of Marshmallow Fluff
- 2 1/2 cups confectioners sugar

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Coat two cake pans with cooking spray.

On medium speed, beat together cake mix, eggs, 1 cup water and oil until blended and thickened. Stir in zucchini. Evenly divide batter between pans.

Bake 28-30 minutes or until toothpick inserted into center comes out clean. Cool on racks 20 minutes. Transfer from pans to racks; cool completely, 30 minutes.

Meanwhile, on medium speed, beat butter until light and fluffy, 2 minutes. Add Fluff; beat until combined. On low, gradually beat in sugar, then coconut and vanilla.

Place one cake layer on serving plate; spread with 1 cup frosting. Top with remaining layer. Spread cake top and side with remaining frosting. Press coconut onto side of cake. If not serving immediately, refrigerate until 30 minutes before serving.
